NEW COACH NEW SCHOOL

From May 2017 a new coach, Rosemary Renatus , a young girl of 22 years hold that already play in the woman national team, starts to collaborate with Twende Hockey.

The field where she will train is the pitch in the sport center of Kidongo Chekundo, where every morning different schools use to go for their sports classes.

Hockey was still not practiced by the schools, even though the field is there, because they were missing a coach. Now, thanks of Rosemary, 4 new primary schools and 2 new secondary schools can start paying hockey and join our program.

With these new schools and their new coach the total number of schools in Dar reaches a good number! Now the next objective is to go into other regions like: Lindi, Tanga, Arusha and Zanzibar.

In fact on June 3 another coach left Dar and went into a new region to start our project.





OLYMPIC DAY

On 23rd of June in the sport center of Kidongo Chekundu in Dar Es Salaam we have celebrated the Olympic Day playing hockey.

In fact we organized a tournament for the primary schools of Dar on the hockey pitch, and we even had a final match of wheel chair hockey in the basketball pitch.

At the tournament participated 9 teams from different parts of Dar Es Salaam: Kigamboni community team A and B, Bombambili primary school, Amani primary school team A B and C, Young unity team, Ukonga primary school and Kawe community team.

The children played a total of 22 matches, 20 in the pool phase and 2 final. Kigamboni B won the final for first and second place against Kigamboni A to become winners of the tournament, while Bombambili won the final for third and fourth position against Amani A.

At the training and the match of wheelchair hockey, had participated 10 young guys and girls with disabilities and 15 girls and guys coming from Juhudi secondary. This is an excellent example of integrating people with disabilities into sports while none of them before have played together and enjoyed together.

The special guest of this day was a member of Tanzanian Olympic committee who explained to the children what the Olympics are and what their importance



is.

It was a great day where many children enjoyed together and learned about the Olympic games and how the sport can integrate all people!
