



Open Education Community is on the road again! Frank Hiddink, one of the community's founders is on his way to Athens to meet with project partners for the Erasmus+ initiative **BioComp**. He will be meeting with project partners from Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Greece, The Netherlands and Romania.

BioComp is a project focused on the bio-based economy (BBE). An online tool is developed to create personalized training programs for workers, teachers, and students in the circular economy. The BBE Competence Navigator tool provides learning materials for topics such as bio-packaging, algae, biogas, and BBE-company.

The BioComp project had their first start-up meeting in Prague, in December 2019 at the University of Chemical Technology. Since then, the partners have worked together online and were able to complete 4 Learning Scenarios with over 15 various modules.

The upcoming meeting in Athens is the first one on location in almost two years. Goal is to plan the Learning Week for teachers & trainers and to start the development of the Best Practice Guide.
